



1° IKU PANAMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP
(INTERNATIONAL KARATE UNION)

JOAO PESSOA / PARABAIA – BRAZIL, FROM JULY 18th TO 22nd, 2018 – GIMANSIO O RONALDAO

The competition is open to all American Federations, IKU members in 2018; it is organized as an IKU (International Karate Union) official competition by the Brazilian Karate Federation CEEBK, in collaboration with FPBKI and is sponsored by the State Government of Parabaia and by the City of Joao Pessoa.

The competition is open to all age categories (from 5 to 60 years old), all competitors must have the necessary medical certification according to the requirements of the Brazilian law.

THE FOREIGN DELEGATIONS THAT NEED A VISA TO ENTER BRAZIL, MAY REQUIRE THE TEMPLATE DIRECTLY TO PRESIDENT GILLES WILLEMIN.

INSTRUCTIONS

- All competitions will take place on 5 tatamis.
- For the affiliated hotel, see the list at the end of this document. Each delegation must book its necessary accommodations by itself.
- The protection equipment (kumite) must comply with what provided for by the competition rules.
- The number of participants to individual competitions (for both kata and kumite) are unlimited; for team competitions only ONE team (kata and kumite) in each category is permitted. Only the hosting nation (Brazil) may participate with TWO teams in each category.
- The referee and coach seminars are FREE, but MANDATORY!!!
- After the seminar, the coaches having attended it, will receive a PERSONAL badge by which they, and they only, may enter (wearing a tracksuit) the competition area.
- The Federations’ Presidents must bear in mind they have to be up to date with the payment of the IKU affiliation fee for 2018; on the contrary, the payment can be also made on site.
- In case a competitor is OUT of his weight category at the moment of checking, he can change category paying the registration fee AGAIN.

ALL FEDERATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO BRING WITH THEM A REFEREE AT LEAST!!!

- The exams for international referee (as well as the qualification achievements) – in this American Continental Championship – shall ONLY give the qualification of CONTINENTAL Referee or Judge and NOT World Referee or Judge.
- Referees from other international Organizations (WKF/IKU/WUKF/WKC/ etc.), may also attend the seminar and, if successful, will achieve the IKU CONTINENTAL qualifications; they are begged to bring with them the documents stating the qualification already obtained in other international Federations.
- Exams for DAN, recognized by IKU with certificate, will take place during the Championship; the candidates are begged to bring with them all documents or certifications (both International and National) previously obtained.
