- Competitors who participate in the Shobu Sanbon individual category **cannot** participate in the Shobu Ippon Individual category, and vice versa, but **can** participate in the Team category of Shobu Ippon and vice versa but not in both team categories.

CONTACT KARATE REGULATION

(Irikumi Ju – Irikumi Go)

Can participate all schools and styles of Contact Karate (Kyokushinkai, Irikumi, Ashihara, Full Contact Karate, and others), with an unlimited number of athletes.

INDIVIDUAL KUMITE IRIKUMI-JU, IRIKUMI-GO

All competitors will compete, divided into the age classes given below, without the division by belts (recommended minimal rank in Kumite Irikumi-ju is the green belt, while in Irikumi-go is the brown belt) with the following weight categories:

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INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

All participants must be equipped with their own regulation safeties (according to the competition rules that they have chosen). Competition will take place with two Contact sections: **Irikumi-go and Irikumi-ju.**

Actually they are two different competitions and athletes can freely choose one or the other one; or both. The main difference between these sections is that the section "Irikumi-ju" prohibits all hits at the head; however it allows full-contact using one's hands, elbows, and knees at the torso, use of legs is allowed at one's legs, thigh, torso and head. In the section of Irikumi-go sportsmen compete with gloves (8-10 ounces) with open fingers. Here all types of hits using hands against one's head are allowed. In both sections the performance of an armlock or choking technique endures 10 seconds. The choice of rules must be specified in your registration form.

Note: (Extract from the rules n.12.) The victory is considered in Irikumi-go or in Irikumi-ju to be as such **when:**

- 1.1. The match has resulted in the victory of one and the defeat of another opponent or both sportsmen.
- 1.2. The winner can achieve "flawless" victory. Technical victory or victory by scores.
- 1.3. **«Flawless» victory is awarded for:**
 - 1.3.1. Technical actions that have led an opponent to knockout;
 - 1.3.2. Technical actions that have led an opponent to 1 or 2 knockdowns respectively;
 - 1.3.3. Refusal to continue the match;
 - 1.3.4. Achievement of total domination over an opponent in a match through 12 and more scores.
- 1.4. Refusal to continue the match is considered as such while:
 - 1.4.1. There is the sign of surrender during an armlock or a choking technique performed by an opponent;
 - 1.4.2. There is a determined will of an opponent to surrender or a decision made by his coach.
- 1.5. **Technical victory is awarded for;**
 - 1.5.1. Absence of the opponent on tatami during 2 minutes.
 - 1.5.2. Call off of an opponent from the match.
 - 1.5.3. Disqualification of an opponent.
- 1.6. Victory by scores is awarded for victory over an opponent through the achievement of scores up to 11.
 - 1.6.1. A victory with a slight advantage is scored for distinction in 1-3 scores respectively.
- 1.7. Defeat to both of the opponents is claimed if;
 - 1.7.1. Both of competitors haven't come for the match.
 - 1.7.2. Both of them are called off from the match for the injuries imposed on both opponents with a condition
That no one of them hasn't trespassed the rules of the competitions;
 - 1.7.3. Mutual knockout;
 - 1.7.4. Mutual disqualification for trespassing these Rules.
- 1.8. In this case, no one enters the next round of the competitions, regulated by the Olympic system, and their Potential opponent will be awarded technical victory.



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TEAM COMPETITION (Irikumi-ju)

The team (without weight categories) will be composed by 3 athletes and one reserve, which can be used to replace an injured athlete, or upon request of the coach. However, the replacement can be done only in the following round.

At the beginning only 3 team athletes, without the reserve, will line up in the area of competition.

A team with only 2 athletes at the beginning will not be allowed to compete and will be declared loser (kiken).

If during the shift, one of the members of the team members is injured and the doctor notices him/her unfit to continue the match the team can continue the match with only two athletes.

The team Kumite competition female and male is only for Irikumi-ju, in the following categories:

- a) Seniors (composed by athletes from 18 up)
- b) Juniors (composed by athletes from 16 to 17 years)

GENERAL RULES

1) All competitors, under the President's responsibility of their federation/association (country), must have regular sanitary certifications according to the laws in force in their own Country and they must be covered by their own insurance. On request the athletes must show a valid identity document and the federal membership card (certifying the grade owned).

2) If during the competitions some categories will have a poor number of athletes registered (less than four) the Organizing Committee will unquestionably arrange the passage of these athletes to the closer category.

3) Seen the nature of this event **no claim will be accepted. Possible pertaining appeals must be immediately made in writing to the Chief Referees, paying the fee of Euro 50, 00 (that will be returned if the appeal will be upheld).**

4) **The organizing committee declines all responsibilities for any accident in which people or things may incur before, during and after the event.**

5) **When the Sports Federations register their athletes, they take upon themselves the responsibility that their own athletes are in conformity to the health certificates and everything provided in the present regulations.**

6) **For what that is not provided in this program remain valid the rules you can see on the website www.ikunion.org**

REFEREE SEMINAR

Each federation is asked to bring at least one referee, who will participate in the seminar and work during the competition (mandatory). At the end of the competition all referees and judges will receive a certificate of participation and a certificate with the qualification achieved. Referees and Judges who possess a qualification from other international federations, IKU will recognise their qualification with a corresponding IKU qualification.

You will then be sent a LOGIN NAME and PASSWORD.

FEES

The fees for abroad participation must be paid in cash (Only US Dollars or INR). Please exchange your national currency before coming to the registration room. & All Indian Players paid in Federation account before last date.



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**Entries to the competition will be open from 1st September and will
Close on 30th of October, 2016**

Federations can edit their entries before the championship in the hall for registration and weighing checks. It is mandatory that the legally responsible person for each federation shall bring the competitors passports to the Registration Room for the official check of the competitors ages. All competitors must come for weigh-in check in the Registration Room, together with their legally responsible person and their passports.

GENERAL REGULATION

- 1) Participants should have their own equipments and other protective guards;
- 2) All Officials should wear official uniform and association tie;
- 3) The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any injuries, damages, losses before during and after the championship;
- 4) Alcoholic drinks, smoking, chewing tobacco and drugs are strictly prohibited at the venue of the championship and accomodation area;
- 5) Participants bellow the age of 18 years he/she has to show evidence proof of his/her date of birth;
- 6) No convenue/transport provide during championship for competitors and officials
